

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy describes Our policies and procedures on the collection, use and disclosure of Your information when You use our website and tells You about Your privacy rights and how the law protects You.

We use Your Personal data to provide and improve our Website. By using our Website, You agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Interpretation and Definitions

Interpretation

The words of which the initial letter is capitalized have meanings defined under the following conditions. The following definitions shall have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or in plural.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

- **You** means the individual accessing or using the Website, or the company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the Website, as applicable.
- **Company** (referred to as either "the Company", "We", "Us" or "Our" in this Agreement) refers to GoldenCare USA, LLC. (a subsidiary of Integrity Marketing Group, LLC), 10700 County Road 15, Plymouth, MN 55441.
- **Affiliate** means an entity that controls, is controlled by or is under common control with a party, where "control" means ownership of 50% or more of the shares, equity interest or other securities entitled to vote for election of directors or other managing authority.
- **Account** means a unique account created for You to access our Website or parts of our Website.
- **Website(s)** refers to the GoldenCare USA websites, accessible from www.goldencare.com, www.goldencaremedicare.com or www.goldencareagent.com
- **Quote** refers to individual(s) you provide information to Us for the purposes of the offering services.
- **Country** refers to: Minnesota, United States
- **Service Provider** means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of the Company. It refers to third-party companies or individuals employed by the Company to facilitate the Program, to provide service on behalf of the Company, to perform services related to the Program or to assist the Company in analyzing how the Program is used.
- **Third-party Social Media Service** refers to any website or any social network website through which a User can log in or create an account to use the Program.
- **Personal Data** is any information that relates to an identified or identifiable individual.
- **Cookies** are small files that are placed on Your computer, mobile device or any other device by a website, containing the details of Your browsing history on that website among its many uses.
- **Device** means any device that can access the Websites such as a computer, a cellphone or a digital tablet.

- **Usage Data** refers to data collected automatically, either generated by the use of the Website or from the Website infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a page visit).
- **Do Not Track (DNT)** is a concept that has been promoted by US regulatory authorities, in particular the U.S. Federal Trade Commission (FTC), for the Internet industry to develop and implement a mechanism for allowing internet users to control the tracking of their online activities across websites.

Collecting and Using Your Personal Data

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data

While using Our Websites, We may ask You to provide Us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify You or Your Lead. Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

- Email address
- First name and last name
- Phone number
- Address, State, Province, ZIP/Postal code, City
- Usage Data

Usage Data

Usage Data is collected automatically when using the Websites. This data is used solely for the purposes of the Websites, and is not shared, sold or distributed to any third-party not directly involved in the necessary operation of the Websites.

Usage Data may include information such as Your Device's Internet Protocol address (e.g. IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our Websites that You visit, the time and date of Your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

When You access the Websites by or through a mobile device, We may collect certain information automatically, including, but not limited to, the type of mobile device You use, Your mobile device unique ID, the IP address of Your mobile device, Your mobile operating system, the type of mobile Internet browser You use, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

We may also collect information that Your browser sends whenever You visit our Websites or when You access the Websites by or through a mobile device.

Tracking Technologies and Cookies

We use Cookies and similar common tracking technologies to track the activity on Our Websites and store certain information. Tracking technologies used are beacons, tags, and scripts to collect and track information and to improve and analyze Our Websites.

You can instruct Your browser to refuse all Cookies or to indicate when a Cookie is being sent.

However, if You do not accept Cookies, You may not be able to use some parts of our Websites.

Cookies can be "Persistent" or "Session" Cookies. Persistent Cookies remain on your personal computer or mobile device when You go offline, while Session Cookies are deleted as soon as You close your web browser. Learn more about cookies: [All About Cookies](#).

We use both session and persistent Cookies for the purposes set out below:

- **Necessary / Essential Cookies**

Type: Session Cookies

Administered by: Us

Purpose: These Cookies are essential to provide You with services available through the Website and to enable You to use some of its features. They help to authenticate users and prevent fraudulent use of user accounts. Without these Cookies, the services that You have asked for cannot be provided, and We only use these Cookies to provide You with those services.

- **Cookies Policy / Notice Acceptance Cookies**

Type: Persistent Cookies

Administered by: Us

Purpose: These Cookies identify if users have accepted the use of cookies on the Website.

- **Functionality Cookies**

Type: Persistent Cookies

Administered by: Us

Purpose: These Cookies allow us to remember choices You make when You use the Website, such as remembering your login details or language preference. The purpose of these Cookies is to provide You with a more personal experience and to avoid You having to re-enter your preferences every time You use the Website.

Use of Personal Data

The Company may use Personal Data for the following purposes:

- **To provide and maintain our Websites**, including to monitor the usage of our Websites.
- **To manage Your Account:** to manage Your registration as a user of the Website. The Personal Data You provide can give You access to different functionalities of the Website that are available to You as a registered user.
- **To contact You:** To contact You by email, telephone calls, SMS, or other equivalent forms of electronic communication, such as a mobile application's push notifications regarding

updates or informative communications related to the functionalities, products or contracted services, including the security updates, when necessary or reasonable for their implementation.

- **To provide You** with occasional news, special offers and general information about other goods, services and events which we offer that are similar to those that you have already used, purchased or inquired about unless You have opted not to receive such information.
- **To manage Your requests:** To attend and manage Your requests to Us.

We only share Your or Your Referred Lead's personal information in the following situations:

- **With Service Providers:** We may share Your personal information with Service Providers to monitor and analyze the use of our Website, to contact You.
- **For Business transfers:** We may share or transfer Your personal information in the unlikely event that it is necessary in connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of Company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of our business to another company.
- **With Affiliates:** Only as necessary to fulfill the usage of the Websites, We may share Your and/or Your Quote information with Our affiliates, in which case we will require those affiliates to honor this Privacy Policy. Affiliates include Our parent company and any other subsidiaries, joint venture partners or other companies that We control or that are under common control with Us.
- **With Business partners:** We may share Your information and/or Quote information with Our business partners to offer designated products or services.

Retention of Personal Data

The Company will retain Your and Your Quote information only for as long as is necessary. We will retain and use Your and/or Your Quote information to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

The Company will also retain Usage Data for internal analysis purposes. Usage Data is generally retained for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to strengthen the security or to improve the functionality of Our Websites, or We are legally obligated to retain this data for longer time periods.

Transfer of Personal Data

Your and/or Your Quote information, including Personal Data, is processed at the Company's operating offices and in other necessary places where the parties involved in the processing and fulfillment of services. It means that, while unlikely, it may be possible that this information may be transferred to – and maintained on – computers located outside of Your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ than those from Your jurisdiction.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by Your submission of such information represents Your agreement to that transfer if fulfillment of Quote and usage of the Websites necessitate said transfer.

The Company will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that Your and/or Quote data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and no transfer of Personal Data will take place to an organization or a country unless there are adequate controls in place including the security of data and other personal information.

Disclosure of Personal Data

Business Transactions

In the unlikely event the Company is involved in a merger, acquisition or asset sale, Your and/or Your Quote data may be transferred.

Law enforcement

Under certain rare circumstances, the Company may be required to disclose Your Personal Data if required to do so by law or in response to valid requests by public authorities (e.g. a court or a government agency).

Other legal requirements

The Company may disclose Your and/or Your Quote data in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to:

- Comply with a legal obligation
- Protect and defend the rights or property of the Company
- Prevent or investigate possible wrongdoing in connection with the Websites
- Protect the personal safety of Users of the Website or the public ☒ Protect against legal liability

Security of Personal Data

The security of Your and Your Quote data is very important to Us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage can be guaranteed to be absolutely 100% secure. While We strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect Personal Data, We cannot guarantee its absolute security.

"Do Not Track" Policy as Required by California Online Privacy Protection Act (CalOPPA)

Our Program systems are not designed to respond to Do Not Track signals.

However, some third party websites do keep track of Your browsing activities.
